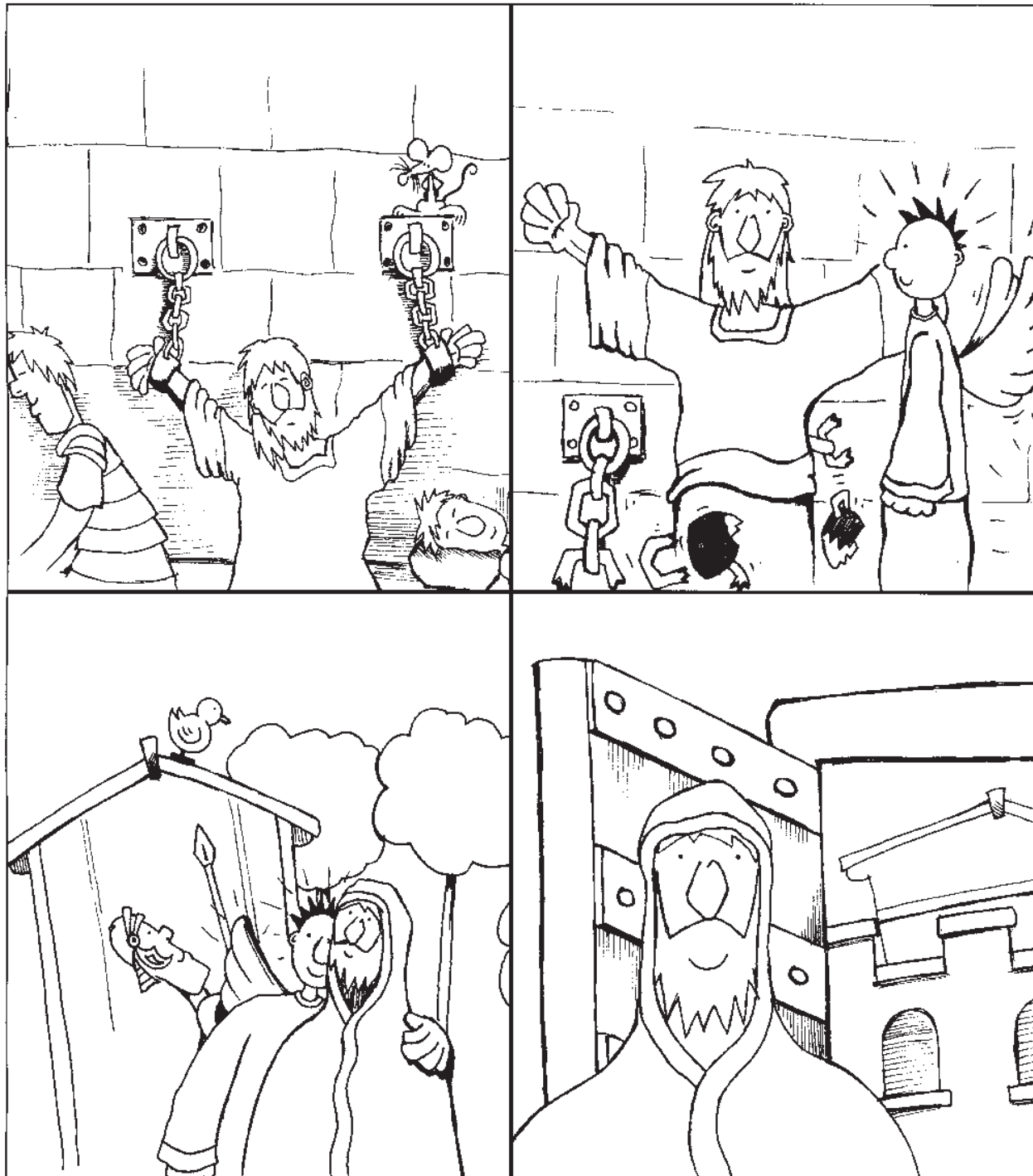


Suggestion

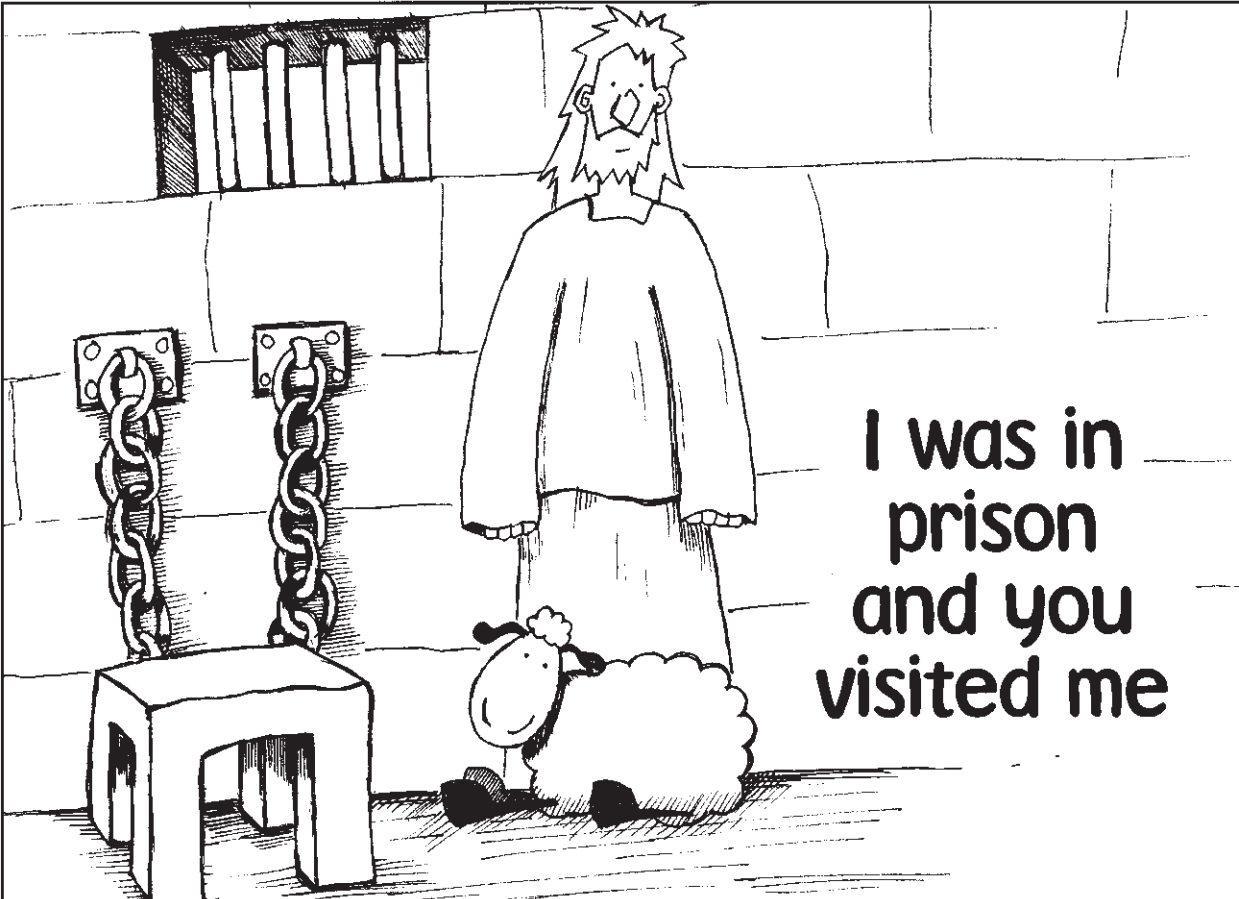
Can you find these words in the grid on the right? Some words go up, some go down, some are even back to front!
