Neurodiversity



Introducing two neurodiversity boxes at HMP Featherstone in both the visitors centre and in the visits hall.

Sensory toys are one of the most effective tools to help neurodiverse young people in their day to day lives. They help young people the calm down, relax, concentrate and focus. They are also help to decrease fear and discomfort.

Inside our boxes are ear defenders, fidget toys and 'Hidden disability' lanyards which can help staff to identify young people with additional needs when in the visitor's Centre, going through the search procedures and in the visits hall.

<u>Increase in Money allowed in on</u> Visits.

From 29th April 2024 you will be allowed to take in £50 per visit.

This money must be in coins only.

If you are worried about your loved one while they are a resident at this prison, you can contact the Safer Custody team on 01902 703081.

You may be asked to leave a voicemail. Please make sure you include:

- Your name.
- •The reason that you are calling.
- •The name of your family member/friend (and their prison number if you know it).

Please wait at least 24 hours for a call back before contacting the prison again. If your concerns are immediate or lifethreatening please call the prison switchboard on 01902 703000.

Visitors Dress Code

Please note the below applies to visitors aged 10 and over, regardless of gender.

No tops or dresses showing cleavage





Skirts, dresses and shorts must be knee length.









No tops showing mid-riff when both sitting

Please note the below applies to all visitors, regardless of age or gender.

No ripped jeans, ripped shorts, ripped leggings, or ripped trousers





No outside jackets, body warmers or hooded clothing. All coats, jackets and hooded clothing must be placed in a locker outside the visits room after being searched



No sunglasses to be worn






