It can be worrying if your loved one has health issues whilst they are inside prison

If you are concerned about the health of your loved one who is currently in HMP Belmarsh, HMP Brixton, HMP Feltham B (over 18s), HMP YOI Isis, HMP Pentonville, HMP Wandsworth or HMP Wormwood Scrubs, you can call Prisoner Health Information and Liaison Line (Call PHILL).

This is a confidential phone line set up for family and friends to share information about the health and wellbeing of people in prison.



## Get a message through to the healthcare team

Use the phone line to share information about your loved one's health. For example:

- Pre-existing conditions of your loved one
- Medications or treatments they usually take
- Use of drugs or alcohol that means they are at risk
- Concerns about mental health or risks to their life



## Share health information in confidence

Our call handlers are healthcare staff and not employed by the prison.

Information received will be shared with the healthcare team looking after your loved one, with the aim of improving their safety and preventing delays in accessing essential medication or support.



In some circumstances, the healthcare team may contact you

It won't always be possible to share information about your loved one back to you, because their medical information may have to remain private.

However in some cases, the service allows members of the healthcare team to make contact with trusted family members.

To make it more likely that you'll receive updates, please ask your loved one to give consent for their information to be shared.
